OTHER REQUIREMENTS AFTER ADMISSION

Evidence of current immunizations required prior to attending classes: Provide photocopies of current Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (DTP) vaccination and Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccination. MMR not necessary if student's birth year is prior to 1956.

- Evidence of English proficiency.
- For non-English speaking countries, the college must receive official IELTS score results of 6.5 or higher (available through British Counsel offices worldwide), or TOEFL Score results of 80 or higher. Test results must be sent directly from the testing service to the Concordia College Office of Graduate & Continuing Studies.
