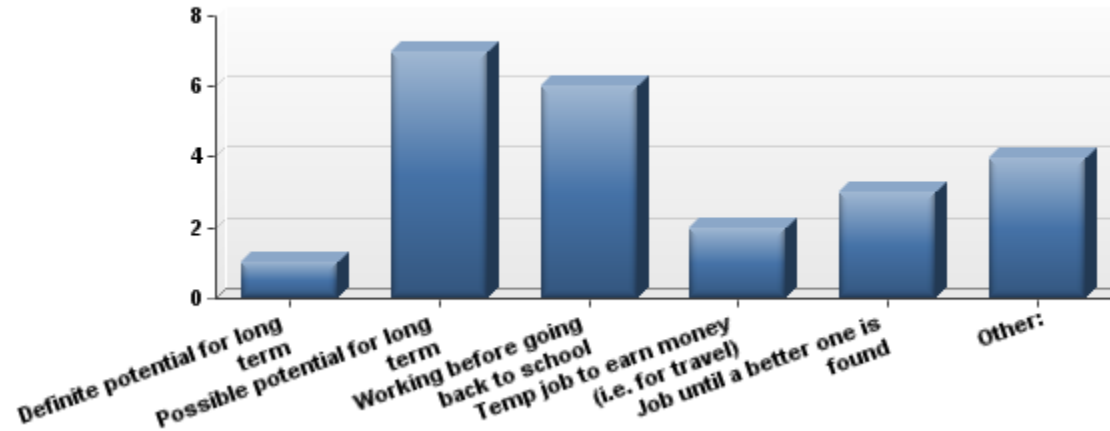



11. What is the highest degree you plan to earn during your lifetime?










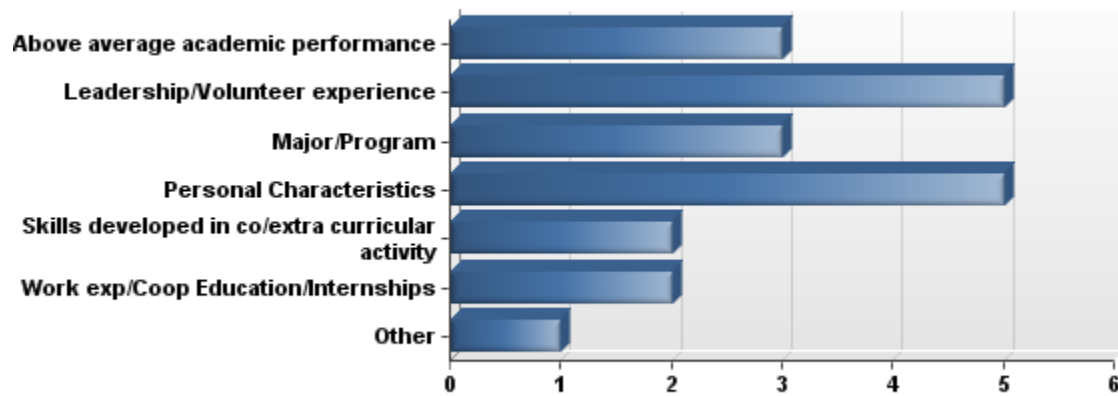
