For performers, your audition should consist of 8 minutes of two contrasting pieces and may include song or dance. Production auditionees should present an organized example of their work within 8 minutes.

## Theatre Performance and Production Résumé

Submit a resume of onstage and backstage theatre involvement and other fine and performing-arts related activities. (You may include music, martial arts, etc.)

## **Essay**

Complete an essay answering the questions: "How do the fine and performing arts contribute to the world in which we live? How do the talents and skills of theatre prepare you for a meaningful life?" Your essay should be a minimum of one and a maximum of three double-spaced pages.
