Office hours: Since I rarely have visitors during official office hours, I'm not going to post hours. However, I am around the building from about 7:30 to 1 daily and usually most afternoons. My office is located behind Mrs Hagen's office. My class schedule is posted outside the door, come by anytime. If I'm not in the office the schedule should give you a clue as to where I may be. If you have trouble locating me for an office visit, please call (and leave a message if I am not there) or see me during class time to schedule a meeting.

From time to time, I will send out emails to the class to notify you of important events or changes. Each of you has a Concordia email address and that is what I will use. You should check this account regularly or have mail there forwarded to an account that you do check often. See me if you have questions.

Attendance is viewed as a gauge of commitment to the class and expected at all lectures and laboratory meetings. Failure to demonstrate a strong commitment in this area will adversely affect your grade. Of course, exceptions are made for emergencies (those things **you** have **no** control over). If you will be absent, try to warn me in advance.

Exams will come material from the lecture and assigned readings. This course will be **cumulative**, we will be building on material and observations throughout the semester. **Lecture and laboratory material will be integrated both in practice and on the exams and quizzes.**

Final Exam will be on Wednesday Dec 16 from 8:30 to 10:30. I am not permitted to make exceptions to this time. If you have more than two exams on that day and want to reschedule the Histo final see **me before Midsemester break.**

Final grade will be based on your lecture and lab exam scores (and factors like attendance), with most of the points on exams toward the end of the semester. There is no predetermined grade distribution (i.e only the top two grades as A, etc), so it is possible that everyone could get an A, but be forewarned, I do not **give** grades, **you earn** them.
